

Before arrival	 Visa Approval Letter (e-VAL): MYR 400 – MYR 600 (Excluding bank charges). Pre-medical check-up: Depending on home appointed clinics. Single Entry Visa (SEV): Depending on Malaysian Embassy / Consulate at home country. Quarantine and COVID-19 test: MYR 1,550 (7 days)
During Registration	 Admission fee: MYR 390 (Undergraduate), MYR 840 (Postgraduate). Tuition fee: As stated on the offer letter. Tuition fees exemption for exchange students from partner universities. Student from non-partner universities should pay full tuition fee with estimation of MYR 2750-MYR 5000 per semester.

	 Accommodation in campus: Single room: MYR 680 monthly. Twin sharing room: MYR 490 monthly. (Student is required to pay a 1+1 rental deposit upon enrolment at the residential college).
