






DAAD funding recipients 2017 – Subject


Approx. 2.7 million students in Germany, around 12 % foreigners.

Attractivity to international students – total score (out of 100)









Different programmes for different purposes

Duration	Short-term research stay (up to 2 years)	Long-term research stay (more than 2 years)	Complete doctorate
Type of funding	Grant / scholarship fellowship / award	Work contract	Funding*
Type of doctorate/ position	Individual doctoral project / structured doctoral programme	Postdoctoral researcher / junior research group leader / junior professorship	Senior researcher / research group leader / professorship

*generally includes own salary and expenses for staff and consumables



Study Scholarship for Artists & Musicians



- Fields: Performing Arts, Fine art, Design/Visual Communication,
 Film, Music and Architecture
- Graduates
- Between 10 and 24 months
- € 850/monthly, health insurance, travel reimbursement
- Deadline: September, October, November 2019




Development-Related Postgraduate Courses (EPOS)

- In Brief Master's degree at a state or state-recognised German university, and in exceptional cases to take a doctoral degree, and to obtain a university qualification (Master's/PhD) in Germany
- Who Graduates with at least two years' professional experience
- **Duration** 12 to 36 months
- Value 750 _ 1000 €/month + additional allowances
- Depending on chosen study programme; please check scholarship brochure or the website of your in chosen study programme

- Funding for study abroad or thesis research
- No subject-related quota
- Previous knowledge of German not required, but advantageous
- Monthly stipend
- Health Insurance
- Travel reimbursement
- All-Grantees meeting in Bonn
- No scholarships for undergraduates ⊗

In Brief Doctoral project (individual or structured programme) at a state-run or state-recognised university or nonuniversity research institute in Germany



- Who?
 PhD students
- Duration?
 Up to 4 years
- Walue? 1,200 €/month + additional allowances

Research grants – One-year and short-term grants

- In Brief Research or training project at a staterun or state-recognised university or non-university research institute in Germany
- Who? PhD students Postdocs / Junior researchers
- Duration? One-year grants: 7–10 months Short-term grants: 1–6 months
- Walue? 1,200 €/month + additional allowances

Research grants – Binationally supervised doctoral degrees

- In Brief Doctoral degree at home university with integrated research phases in Germany
- Who? PhD students
- Duration? Up to 2 years
- Value? Grant: 1,200 €/month + additional allowances during stay(s) in Germany



- Kongressreisenprogramm



- Financial support for academic information visits to Germany for groups of students
- Requirements:
 - Group of 10 to 15 students plus one accompanying faculty member
 - Trip for 7 to 12 days



- Visit should be organized entirely by the home institution
- Application: filed by a faculty member, including total budget, a detailed itinerary, specific information about relationship to the curriculum, application form

Deadlines: November 1 (for trips between March 1 and June 1 of the following year) February 1 (for trips between June 1 and September 1 of the same year) May 1 (for trips no earlier than September 1 of the same year)

The German Research Foundation (DFG) Who we are...

Who we are:

- Central public funding organization for basic research in Germany
- A self-governing body of science and research
- Member organization (universities, academies, research organizations)
- ► The budget in 2017:

approx. € 3 billion in direct research funding

provided primarily by the federal government and

the 16 German Länder



The German Research Foundation (DFG) ... and how we work

- DFG acts and funds bottom up
- no thematic priorities (rare exceptions)
- > **no calls, no deadlines** (rare exceptions)
- no regional priorities
- > no political priorities
- no political influence
- funding only if institution agrees
 on ethical standards
 - everything in competition
 - everything in peer review



Funding of International Cooperations Research Grant



Funding can include

- Staff: PhD-students, post-docs; non-permanent staff
- funding for direct project costs
- Mobility: Travel allowances
- Consumables, scientific instrumentation
- other items such as **publications**, trial-related expenses, PR activities


